Preface

ne of the most fascinating verses in the Bible concerning the prophecies which were written about Christ is found in (Acts 13:29) "And when they had fulfilled all that was written of him, they took him down from the tree, and laid him in a sepulcher."

Truly this is the most powerful and profound statement written to explain in a vivid way the fulfillment of prophecies concerning Christ. For when they had fulfilled all that was written of Him they took Him from the tree and laid Him in a sepulcher.

Here the writer had in mind that Christ did not come out of the blue as other prophets did, but He came according to the plan of God which He had purposed in Himself before the foundation of the world. Indeed these prophecies serve as sign posts leading people to Christ, the Son of prophecies. For this very reason we see that when Philip found Nathaniel said unto him, we have found Him, of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph. (John 1:45)

In the same manner the Lord Jesus after His resurrection, reminded the unbelieving disciples of this great fact, which is recorded in the gospel of Luke saying: "And he said unto them, These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me".(Luke 24:44)

There are over 380 prophecies in the Old Testament which were fulfilled marvelously and miraculously in none other than the person of Jesus Christ. Thirty three of these prophecies were fulfilled in one day, the day of the crucifixion.

It Is Not By Mere Chance

hroughout the pages of the Bible from Genesis to Revelation, we can clearly see the documentation of the events pivoting around one person who is to come to save the world from sin. The Old Testament paves the way through its countless prophecies, types, and shadows proclaiming all the details of His coming. For we read in Genesis chapter 3, that after Eve heard the declaration of war between God and Satan in the Garden of Eden, that a man will be born from the seed of the woman, who will bruise the head of Satan, and Satan will bruise His heel. This declaration of war was uttered by God Himself when He spoke to the serpent saying: "And I will put enmity between you and the woman and between your seed and her seed, He (Christ) will bruise your head and you will bruise His heel." (Gen 3:15). It is evident that there is no one whom we can call the seed of the woman except Jesus Christ, for every human being is born of man, except Jesus Christ, who is truly the seed of the woman for He has no human father.

When Eve heard the verdict from the Lord in the garden of Eden, and when she had her first son, she thought that it is her son who will bruise the serpent's head so she called his name Cain saying: "I have gotten a man from the Lord." But Cain was born from the seed of the man, Adam, and not from the Lord.

Later on, the bells of prophecy in the Old Testament clearly tolled to indicate that the Promised One will be born from the lineage of Abraham of whose seed all the families of the earth will be blessed (Gen.12:3). This promise was assured to Abraham's son Isaac and then to Isaac's son Jacob, who had twelve sons. Before his death, Jacob gathered his children and blessed them, and foretold that his son Judah will be the one from whom the

Promised One will come saying: "The scepter shall not depart from Judah nor a lawgiver from between his feet until Shiloh comes and unto him shall be the obedience of the people." (Gen. 49:10). The word Shiloh means that He will be the one who carries the government upon his shoulder. (Isa.9:6).

Further still, throughout the Old Testament the bells continue to peal out the sound that He shall be born of a virgin, for the Prophet Isaiah said: "Behold a virgin shall conceive and shall bring forth a son and His name shall be Immanuel." (Isaiah 7:14)

As the years went by the bells of Prophecy reverberated the sound to announce that this Savior whom all the ages await, shall be born in Bethlehem of Judea as it is recorded by the prophet Micah:

"But you Bethlehem Ephrathah. Though you are little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall come forth to Me. The One to be ruler in Israel. Whose going forth have been from of old. From everlasting." (Micah 5:2)

We have to remember that when Adam and Eve sinned and saw their nakedness, the Lord God sacrificed an animal, shed its blood, and made tunics to cover their nakedness. teaching them that through this act an innocent animal should die in their place.

Adam learned that the only way to cover sin is through the blood. So he taught his sons Cain and Able to do. Abel had learned from the coats of skin; with which God had clothed his parents, that "without shedding of blood there is no remission of sin." For this purpose, he did offer to God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain through which he obtained witness that he was righteous.

Noah, after the flood offered sacrifices of every clean animal and of every clean bird (clean animal and clean bird is a type of Christ humanity and divinity, earthly and heavenly).

IT IS NOT BY MERE CHANCE

The prophet Moses also learned from observing the Passover, and the sprinkling of blood upon the two door posts in Egypt, that the only way to escape the judgment of God is through the blood. For he had seen that the lamb which was slain as a substitute for the first born was the only means for his salvation.

Abraham, on Mount Moriah, learned from the ram which the Lord had provided, the meaning of substitution and redemption, as he took the ram and offered it in the place of his son Isaac.

The question echoes itself through the ages, "Is it by mere chance that a place called Golgotha is located in the same area of Mount Moriah?"

Is it by mere chance that King Solomon built the temple of God on that same mountain, to offer sacrifices unto the Lord there? (1Chr.3:1)

Is it by mere chance that two thousand years later, the one who was born of a virgin was driven to the same area to be hung on a cross as the ultimate sacrifice for the sin of the world?

Is it a mere happenstance that the Prophet Isaiah had written about the death of Christ seven hundred years prior to its occurrence by saying: "He is despised and rejected of men. A man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him. Surely He has borne our grief. And carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken. Smitten by God and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities . . . He was oppressed and He was afflicted. Yet He opened not His mouth. He was led as a lamb to the slaughter. And as a sheep before its shearers is silent. So He opened not His mouth." (Isaiah 53:3-5,8)

Was it a mere coincidence that John the Baptist pointed at Him saying: "Behold the lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world?" (John 1:29)

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Is it possible that the carpenter from Galilee is the anticipated Messiah, in whom all the prophecies in the Holy Scriptures have been fulfilled?

Was He born of a virgin as Isaiah had prophesied? (Isaiah 7:47) Of the thousand cities and towns in the world, was He born in Bethlehem of Judea as Micah had prophesied? (Micah 5:2)

Was He betrayed by one of His close comrades as David had prophesied? (Psalm 55:12-14)

Was He sentenced to die on the Cross as David had prophesied? (Psalm 22:16)

Was He given vinegar to drink in the hour of his thirst as the psalmist recorded? (Psalm 69:21)

Was He crucified between the wicked as Isaiah the prophet foretold? (Isaiah 53:12)

Were His hands and feet pierced as the psalmist prophesied over a thousand years prior to His death? (Psalm 22:16)

Did He carry the sins of many? And did He intercede for sinners as Isaiah predicted? (Isaiah 53:12).

Was He buried in a rich man's tomb as Isaiah recorded? (Isaiah 53:9).

Was He risen from the dead as David prophesied? (Psalm 16:10).

Many questions run through our minds when we read about the hundreds or more detailed prophecies about His birth, His life, His death and resurrection which would have never been fulfilled, but in Him.

The Writer of the book of Hebrews recorded: "God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in times past to the fathers by the prophets, has in these last days spoken to us by His son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds; Who being the brightness of His glory and the express image

of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sin, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on High" (Hebrews 1:1 3), indicating that Jesus the Messiah is the Only Son of God, and the one in whom all the promises of the Old Testament has been fulfilled.

After fulfilling all the prophecies and all that was written about Him, Jesus ascended to heaven and all humanity is waiting now for His glorious return, to fulfill the remainder of the prophecies, to rapture the believers, and to set up His kingdom. He has kept His word and fulfilled all the previous prophecies, and now we are anticipating the fulfillment of the remaining ones.

It is of little wonder to read what Luke wrote in the book of Acts saying: "To Him give all the prophets witness, that through His name, whoever believes in Him will receive remission of sin" (Acts 10:43)

Throughout the coming pages, dear reader, we will try to take you on a journey, to the scrolls of the Holy Scriptures, both the Old and the New Testaments, so you may read about the testimonies that the prophets of old had given about this Wonderful Savior, and to witness the actualization of these prophecies in the pages of the New Testament.

I pray to the Lord Almighty that He would give you a clear and distinct revelation of the nature of this Wonderful Savior, and that you may come to know and accept Him as your personal Savior, so you would be born again and receive everlasting life. "For whoever shall calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." (Rom 10:13)

The Book of Genesis

CHRIST THE ETERNAL Gen. 1:1

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

The word God is in the plural form-Elohim-and the word created is in the singular form-bara-).

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. (John 1:1,14)

For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him. (Col 1:16)

Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was glad. Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham? Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am. (John 8:56 58)

Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds; Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high. (Heb 1:23)

CHRIST THE CREATOR Gen. 1:3

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth....And God said. (the word of God) Let there be light.

For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him. (Col 1:16)

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He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not. (John 1:10)

ADAM AND EVE ARE TYPES OF CHRIST AND THE CHURCH Gen. 2:21-23

And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof; And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man. And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.

For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones. For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh. (Eph 5:30-31)

CHRIST FROM THE SEED OF THE WOMAN Gen. 3:15

And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

But when the fullness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law.. (Gal 4:4)

This is the first prophecy in scripture. For the one who is going to be the "seed of the woman" was to bruise the head of the serpent which is Satan (Rev. 12:9), but in doing so, He was to suffer. His own heel was to be bruised.

CHRIST THE SUBSTITUTED SACRIFICE Gen. 3:21

Unto Adam also and to his wife did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them.

The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world. (John 1:29)

This is the first sacrificed the Lord God did Himself to cover Adam and Eve, telling them that "without shedding of blood there is no remission of sin."

CHRIST THE LAMB OF GOD Gen. 4:4

And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering:

The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world. (John 1:29)

The sacrifice of Cain was not accepted "For the blood that makes atonement for the soul." (Lev.17:11). And without shedding of blood there is no remission of sin." (Heb.9:22)

CHRIST THE BURNT OFFERING Gen. 8:20

And Noah builded an altar unto the LORD; and took of every clean beast, and of every clean fowl, and offered burnt offerings on the altar. (clean beast is a type of Christ's humanity, clean fowl is a type of His divinity)

For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins. Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but a body hast thou prepared me: In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin thou hast had no pleasure. Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O God. Above when he said, Sacrifice and offering and burnt offerings and offering for sin thou wouldest not, neither hadst pleasure therein; which are offered by the law; Then said he, Lo, I come to do thy will, O God. He taketh away the first, that he may establish the second. By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. (Heb 10:4-10)

CHRIST THE SEED OF SHEM Gen. 9:26

And he said, Blessed be the LORD God of Shem; and Canaan shall be his servant.

Which was the son of Cainan, which was the son of Arphaxad, which was the son of Sem, which was the son of Noe, which was the son of Lamech. (Luke 3:36)

CHRIST THE SEED OF ABRAHAM Gen. 12:3

And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham. Abraham begat Isaac; and Isaac begat Jacob; and Jacob begat Judas and his brethren. (Mat 1:1 2)

Ye are the children of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, And in thy seed shall all the kindred of the earth be blessed. Unto you first God, having raised up his Son Jesus, ent him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities. (Acts 3:26-27)

CHRIST A PRIEST AFTER THE ORDER OF MELCHIZEDEK Gen. 14:18

And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God.

Whither the forerunner is for us entered, even Jesus, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec. (Heb 6:20)

MELCHIZEDEK A TYPE OF CHRIST Gen. 14:18

And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God.

To whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all; first being by interpretation King of righteousness, and after that also King of Salem, which is, King of peace; Without father, without mother, without descent, having neither beginning of days, nor end of life; but made like unto the Son of God; abideth a priest continually. (Heb 7:2)

CHRIST FROM THE SEED OF ISAAC Gen. 17:19

And God said, Sarah thy wife shall bear thee a son indeed; and thou shalt call his name Isaac: and I will establish my covenant with him for an everlasting covenant, and with his seed after him.

Neither, because they are the seed of Abraham, are they all children: but, In Isaac shall thy seed be called. (Rom 9:7)

Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ. (Gal 3:16)

THE LORD'S APPEARANCE TO ABRAHAM IN THE FLESH Gen. 18:1

And the LORD appeared unto him in the plains of Mamre: and he sat in the tent door in the heat of the day;

And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory. (1Tim 3:16)

CHRIST THE JUDGE OF ALL THE EARTH Gen. 18:25

That be far from thee to do after this manner, to slay the righteous with the wicked: and that the righteous should be as the wicked, that be far from thee: Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?

For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son: That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him. (John 5:22-23)

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BEFORE ABRAHAM WAS, I AM Gen. 18:33

Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was glad. Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham? Jesus said unto the Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am. (John 8:56-58)

SON OF ISAAC Gen. 21:12

And God said unto Abraham, Let it not be grievous in thy sight because of the lad, and because of thy bondwoman; in all that Sarah hath said unto thee, hearken unto her voice; for in Isaac shall thy seed be called.

And Jesus himself began to be about thirty years of age, being (as was supposed) the son of Joseph, which was the son of Heli,...

Which was the son of Jacob, which was the son of Isaac, which was the son of Abraham, which was the son of Thara, which was the son of Nachor. (Luke 3:23, 34)

Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ. (Gal 3:16)

CHRIST THE LAMB OF GOD Gen. 22:8

And Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together.

The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world. (John 1:29)

Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers. (1 Pet 1:18)

CHRIST OUR SUBSTITUTE Gen. 22:13

And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind him a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham

went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son.

For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; (1 Cor 15:3)

CHRIST THE SEED OF ABRAHAM Gen. 22:18

And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.

Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ. (Gal 3:16)

REBEKAH (ISAAC'S BRIDE) Gen. 22:23

And Bethuel begat Rebekah: these eight Milcah did bear to Nahor, Abraham's brother.

Rebekah (Isaac's bride) was born after Isaac was put on the altar, the Church (The bride of Christ) was born after Christ was crucified.

Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it. (Eph 5:25)

The seed of Isaac will be as the stars of heaven (heavenly- the Church). Gen. 26:4

And I will make thy seed to multiply as the stars of heaven, and will give unto thy seed all these countries; and in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed;

By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten son. Of whom it was said, That in Isaac shall thy seed be called. (Heb 11:17-18)

THE LADDER IS A TYPE OF CHRIST Gen. 28:12

And he dreamed, and behold a ladder set up on the earth,

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and the top of it reached to heaven: and behold the angels of God ascending and descending on it.

And he saith unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Hereafter ye shall see heaven open, and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of man. (John 1:51)

For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; (1 Tim 2:5)

CHRIST CAME FROM THE SEED OF JACOB Gen. 28:14

And thy seed shall be as the dust of the earth, and thou shalt spread abroad to the west, and to the east, and to the north, and to the south: and in thee and in thy seed shall all the families of the earth be blessed.

Abraham begat Isaac; and Isaac begat Jacob; and Jacob begat Judas and his brethren. (Mat 1:2)

JOSEPH IS A TYPE OF CHRIST Gen. 39-50

He was his father's beloved son.

He lived in Hebron which meant (fellowship) where He had been in constant fellowship with His father, before He was sent to Shekim which meant (the shoulder) the place of toil and trouble.

He was a shepherd.

His father sent Him to check the well-being of His brethren.

His brethren conspired against Him.

His brethren were envious of Him.

Joseph was thrown into the well.

He came out of the well alive.

He was sold for twenty pieces of silver.

He became a slave.

He was tempted, but did not give in to temptation.

He was falsely accused.

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He did not try to defend Himself.

He was afflicted at the hands of the gentiles.

He was imprisoned for no guilt on his part.

One of the prisoners was set free, the other one was condemned.

He was counted with the criminals.

Joseph's entire prophecies were fulfilled.

Joseph was absent from his brethren.

Joseph was thirty years old when he started on his commission.

He was called Zephanat Fanih which meant the savior of the world.

Joseph was the only one who was able to give bread to the starving dying world.

Joseph met with his brethren for the first time, he recognized them while they did not.

Joseph inflicts tribulation over his brethren.

Joseph announces himself to his brethren.

Joseph's brethren confessed their sin to God.

Joseph treated his brethren with great grace.

Joseph forgave his brethren.

CHRIST CAME FROM THE SEED OF JUDAH Gen. 49:8-10

Judah, thou art he whom thy brethren shall praise: thy hand shall be in the neck of thine enemies; thy father's children shall bow down before thee. Judah is a lion's whelp: from the prey, my son, thou art gone up: he stooped down, he couched as a lion, and as an old lion; who shall rouse him up? The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; (reference to Christ) and unto him shall the gathering of the people be.

And Judas begat Phares and Zara of Thamar; and Phares begat Esrom; and Esrom begat Aram. (Mat 1:3)

THE BOOK OF GENESIS

CHRIST IS THE SALVATION WHICH THE PEOPLE WERE WAITING FOR Gen 49:19

I have waited for thy salvation, O LORD.

And it was revealed unto him by the Holy Ghost, that he should not see death, before he had seen the Lord's Christ. And he came by the Spirit into the temple: and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him after the custom of the law, Then took he him up in his arms, and blessed God, and said, Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word: For mine eyes have seen thy salvation. (Luke 2:26-30)

Of which salvation the prophets have inquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace that should come unto you. (1 Pet 1:10)

HIDDEN TREASURES IN GENESIS

In Genesis chapter five, God has hidden for us the story of redemption Through the names which are mentioned in this chapter.

The first name is **Seth** meaning "It is appointed". **Enos** follows next and it means "mortal man". Then comes **Cenan** whose name bears the meaning of "sorrow", while **Mahlial** which follows means "the Blessed God". **Jared** means "shall come down", and **Enoch** means "teaching". Later comes **Metushaleh**, which means literally "his death shall bring". Then we come to **Lamech**, which means "the despairing one", and finally **Noah**, which is "comfort".

If we put the meaning of the names together we get the following:

It is appointed unto mortal man sorrow, but the Blessed God came down teaching that His death shall bring to the despairing one comfort.

The Book of Exodus

CHRIST'S APPEARANCE IN THE FLESH Ex. 3:2-3

And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed. And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt.

And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, "Moses, Moses." And he said, "Here am I."

And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory. (1 Tim 3:16)

CHRIST IS THE GREAT I AM Ex. 3:13-14

And Moses said unto God, Behold, when I come unto the children of Israel, and shall say unto them, The God of your fathers hath sent me unto you; and they shall say to me, What is his name? what shall I say unto them? And God said unto Moses, "I AM THAT I AM": and he said, "Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you."

Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was glad. Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham? Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am. (John 8:56-58)

As soon then as he had said unto them, I am he, they went backward, and fell to the ground. (John 18:6)

Jesus saith unto her, I that speak unto thee am he. (John 4:26)

THE BOOK OF EXODUS

THE PASSOVER LAMB IS A TYPE OF CHRIST THE LAMB OF GOD Ex. 12:5

Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take it out from the sheep, or from the goats:

Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot. (1 Pet 1:18-19)

THE LAMB SHOULD BE KILLED Ex. 12:13

And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt.

But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him. (Rom 5:8-9)

CHRIST OUR PASSOVER Ex .12:21 27

Then Moses called for all the elders of Israel, and said unto them, Draw out and take you a lamb according to your families, and kill the Passover. And ye shall take a bunch of hyssop, and dip it in the blood that is in the basin, and strike the lintel and the two side posts with the blood that is in the basin; and none of you shall go out at the door of his house until the morning. For the LORD will pass through to smite the Egyptians; and when he seeth the blood upon the lintel, and on the two side posts, the LORD will pass over the door, and will not suffer the destroyer to come in unto your houses to smite you.

Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us: (1 Cor 5:7)

THE BLOOD OF THE LAMB THAT SAVES FROM DEATH Ex. 12:30

And Pharaoh rose up in the night, he, and all his servants, and all the Egyptians; and there was a great cry in Egypt; for there was not a house where there was not one dead.

For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. (Rom 6:23)

None of his bones shall be broken Ex. 12:46

In one house shall it be eaten; thou shalt not carry forth ought of the flesh abroad out of the house; neither shall ye break a bone thereof.

The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the cross on the Sabbath day, (for that Sabbath day was an high day,) besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and that they might be taken away. Then came the soldiers, and brake the legs of the first, and of the other which was crucified with him. But when they came to Jesus, and saw that he was dead already, they brake not his legs: (John 19:31-33)

THE BITTER WATER OF THIS WORLD IS MADE SWEET IN THE CROSS OF CHRIST Ex. 15:25

And he cried unto the LORD; and the LORD showed him a tree, which when he had cast into the waters, the waters were made sweet: there he made for them a statute and an ordinance, and there he proved them,

Jesus answered and said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again: But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life. (John 4:13-14)

THE BOOK OF EXODUS

Manna is a type of Christ (the Bread of Life) Ex. 16:15

The word manna is a Hebrew word which means" What is this?" When Christ came, the people, even His disciples did not recognize Him, and they said among themselves "Who is this"? Even the wind and the waves obey Him.

And when the children of Israel saw it, they said one to another, What is it? for they wist not what it was. And Moses said unto them, This is the bread which the LORD hath given you to eat.

And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him? (Mark 4:41).

Our fathers did eat manna in the desert; as it is written, He gave them bread from heaven to eat. Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Moses gave you not that bread from heaven; but my Father giveth you the true bread from heaven. For the bread of God is he which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world. Then said they unto him, Lord, evermore give us this bread. And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst. (John 6:31-35)

Manna is the type of Christ for the following:

In its name: "What is this?"

In its importance: It nourishes and sustains, giving life as Christ the Bread of Life.

In its characteristics:

- (a) Small as the seed of coriander. Symbol of His humility.
- (b) White symbolizing His purity.
- (c) Round symbolizing His eternal character.
- (d) Sweet as honey.

JESUS, THE CENTER OF PROPHECIES

METHOD OF OBTAINING THE MANNA

It was easily accessible at the gate of the tent, "the Lord is close for all those who call upon Him."

It fell on dry and barren land. Similarly, Christ came when the people were dry spiritually.

Its price: Free to all.... Salvation is free to all those who ask.

The way it was collected: Man must bow down toward the ground in order to pick it up or else he dies of hunger. The Lord hates all those who have a haughty spirit.

The time which it should be gathered. Early in the morning, so He might in all things have the preeminence.

The urgency of obtaining it: Soon for when the sun became hot. It melted. "Now is the time for salvation."

The Only nourishment:

- (a) Christ is the only bread coming from heaven for salvation, "I am the bread of life."
 - (b) Christ is the only Savior (Acts 4:12).
 - (c) Christ is the only Mediator (I Tim. 2:5).
 - (d) Christ is the only Intercessor (2 John 2:2)
 - (e) Christ is the only Way (John 14:6).
 - (f) Christ is the only Door (John 10:9).
 - (g) Christ is the only foundation (I Cor 3:12)

Jesus is perfect in all:

To the builder, He is the corner stone.

To the thirsty, He is the water of life.

To the dead, He is the resurrection and the life.

To the lost, He is the way.

To the judge, He is the truth.

To the weary, He is rest.

THE BOOK OF EXODUS

To the sad, He is the comforter.

To the sick, He is the healer.

To the disciples, He is the good teacher

To the news reporter, He is the good news.

To the sheep, He is the good shepherd.

To the writer He is the Alpha and Omega.

To the vine dresser, He is the true vine.

To the florist, He is the rose of Sharon and the lily of the valley.

To the jeweler, He is the merchant that seeks the goodly pearl.

To those who wander in darkness, He is the light.

But greatest of all is that, to the sinner, He is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.

THE SMITTEN ROCK IS A TYPE OF CHRIST Ex.17:3-6

And the people thirsted there for water; and the people murmured against Moses, and said, Wherefore is this that thou hast brought us up out of Egypt, to kill us and our children and our cattle with thirst? And Moses cried unto the LORD, saying, What shall I do unto this people? they be almost ready to stone me. And the LORD said unto Moses, Go on before the people, and take with thee of the elders of Israel; and thy rod, wherewith thou smotest the river, take in thine hand, and go. Behold, I will stand before thee there upon the rock in Horeb; and thou shalt smite the rock, and there shall come water out of it, that the people may drink. And Moses did so in the sight of the elders of Israel.

And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ. (1 Cor 10:4)

Christ was smitten for the sin of the people (Isa.53:8)

Christ after He was smitten the Holy Spirit was given. (John 7: 38-39)

JESUS, THE CENTER OF PROPHECIES

Christ is the rock to quench the thirst of all who thirst (John 17:6)

Christ after He was smitten, Salvation came to all who trust in Him freely.

The rock was to be smitten only once. In the same manner Christ was to be smitten only once for our sin. (Heb.7:27-29)

In the book of Numbers. The Lord asked Moses to speak to the rock (Num. 20:8), Moses went and smote the rock and thus he disobeyed God and was denied the privilege to enter into the promised land. The reason for that Jesus was to be smitten only once for our sin (Heb 7:27-29). After Christ's crucification, when the believer sins, he goes to the Lord and speaks to Him in prayers and confession. He does not need Him to be crucified again for his sins, for "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all our unrighteousness." (1 John 1:9)

CHRIST'S INCARNATION Ex. 33:18, 20

And he said, I beseech thee, show me thy glory.. And he said, Thou canst not see my face: for there shall no man see me, and live.

Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high; (Heb. 1:3)

For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. (2Cor 4:6)

Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Show us the Father? (John 14:9)

And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld

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his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. (John 1:14)

CHRIST IN THE TABERNACLE Ex. 36-40

The Tabernacle is a meeting place for God to meet with His people....The word became flesh and dwelt among us (tabernacled among us) Christ is Emmanuel, God with us.

The Tabernacle is a type of Christ for the following reasons.

- (1) From the outside it has no beauty
- (2) From the inside: It is beautiful.
 - (a) It has one door (Christ is the only door to God)
 - (b) The candlestick is a type pf Christ as the only light of the world.
 - (c) The alter of incense represent worship
 - (d) The laver for cleansing. Type of the word of God
 - (e) The Showbread is a type Christ the Bread of Life.
 - (f) The Mercy Seat. Type of Christ's intercession made on the basis of His sacrifice

The Book of Leviticus

CHRIST IS THE BURNT OFFERING Lev. 1:4

And he shall put his hand upon the head of the burnt offering; and it shall be accepted for him to make atonement for him.

And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling savor.. (Eph 5:2)

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. (Rom 12:1)

CHRIST IS THE MEAT OFFERING Lev. 2:1

And when any will offer a meat offering unto the LORD, his offering shall be of fine flour; and he shall pour oil upon it, and put frankincense thereon:

And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God. (Luke 1:35)

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the broken-hearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, (Luke 4:18)

The flour represents Christ in His refined life, and the oil represents the Holy Spirit, and the unleavened bread represents the purity of life. The flour which is mingled with oil, represent the immaculate conception of Christ. (The Holy Spirit will come upon thee) and the flour mixed with oil represents the anointment of Christ by the Holy Spirit.

THE BOOK OF LEVITICUS

CHRIST IS THE PEACE OFFERING Lev. 3:1

Christ in His death provided means of acquiring peace with God for us.

And if his oblation be a sacrifice of peace offering, if he offer it of the herd; whether it be a male or female, he shall offer it without blemish before the LORD.

And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven. (Col 1:20)

For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us; (Eph 2:14)

Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: (Rom 5:1)

Christ is the sin offering Lev. 4:1-4

And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, If a soul shall sin through ignorance against any of the commandments of the LORD concerning things which ought not to be done, and shall do against any of them If the priest that is anointed do sin according to the sin of the people; then let him bring for his sin, which he hath sinned, a young bullock without blemish unto the LORD for a sin offering. And he shall bring the bullock unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before the LORD; and shall lay his hand upon the bullock's head, and kill the bullock before the LORD.

For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him. (2 Cor 5:21)

The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world. (John 1:29)

CHRIST IS THE TRESPASS OFFERING Lev. 5:5.6

And it shall be, when he shall be guilty in one of these things, that he shall confess that he hath sinned in that thing: And he shall bring his trespass offering unto the LORD for his sin which he hath sinned, a female from the flock, a lamb or a kid of the goats, for a sin offering; and the priest shall make an atonement for him concerning his sin.

Saying, Blessed are they whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered. (Rom 4:7,25)

For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more. (Heb 8:12)

CHRIST SUFFERED OUTSIDE THE CAMP Lev. 16:20-22

And when he hath made an end of reconciling the holy place, and the tabernacle of the congregation, and the altar, he shall bring the live goat: And Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send him away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness: And the goat shall bear upon him all their iniquities unto a land not inhabited: and he shall let go the goat in the wilderness.

For the bodies of those beasts, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned without the camp. Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate. (Heb 13:11 12)

THE BLOOD MAKES THE ATONEMENT FOR SIN Lev. 17:11

For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.

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For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins. (Mat 26:28)

For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many. (Mark 10:45)

THE FEASTS AS A TYPE OF CHRIST:

THE FEAST OF THE PASSOVER Lev. 23:4-5

These are the feasts of the LORD, even holy convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons. In the fourteenth day of the first month at even is the Lord's Passover.

"For Christ our Passover was slain for us death for us." (1Cor 5:7)
God's only way of salvation through the blood of the lamb which was:

Flawless.

Set apart and tested.

Slain at twilight God's Word is the only way of assurance

The blood to be applied

When I see the blood, not your feeling, but the fact of the blood applied.

THE FEAST OF UNLEAVENED BREAD IS A TYPE OF CHRIST THE LIVING BREAD Lev. 23:6

And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the feast of unleavened bread unto the LORD: seven days ye must eat unleavened bread.

Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us: Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth. (1 Cor 5: 7-8)

And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall

come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God. (Luke 1:35)

Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: (1Pet 2:22)

THE FEAST OF THE FIRST FRUIT...

Type of Christ's resurrection Lev. 23:10-11

And the Lord spake unto Moses saying: Speak unto the children of Israel and say Unto them, when ye come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the Harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the first fruits of your harvest unto the priest. And he shall wave the sheaf before the Lord, to be accepted for you on the morrow after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it.

But every man in his own order: Christ the first fruits; afterward they that are Christ's at his coming. (1 Cor 15:23)

THE FEAST OF PENTECOST.

Type of the coming of The Holy Spirit Lev. 23:15-17

And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the Sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven Sabbaths shall be complete: Even unto the morrow after the seventh Sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the LORD. Ye shall bring out of your habitations two wave loaves of two tenth deals: they shall be of fine flour; they shall be baken with leaven; they are the first fruits unto the LORD.

And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the

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Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. (Acts 2:1 4)

THE FEAST OF TRUMPETS...

Type of the second coming of Christ Lev. 23:24

Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a Sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation.

But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him. For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore comfort one another with these words. (1 Th 4:13 18)

Behold, I show you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory. O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory? The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law. But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, my beloved

brethren, be ye steadfast, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labor is not in vain in the Lord. (1Cor 15:51 58)

And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other. (Mat 24:31)

THE FEAST OF THE DAY OF ATONEMENT Lev. 23:27

Also on the tenth day of this seventh month there shall be a day of atonement: it shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

Saying, Blessed are they whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered. Blessed is the man to whom the Lord will not impute sin. (Rom 4:7-8)

THE FEAST OF TABERNACLE.

Type of the reign of Christ Lev. 23:40-42

And ye shall take you on the first day the boughs of goodly trees, branches of palm trees, and the boughs of thick trees, and willows of the brook; and ye shall rejoice before the LORD your God seven days. And ye shall keep it a feast unto the LORD seven days in the year. It shall be a statute for ever in your generations: ye shall celebrate it in the seventh month. Ye shall dwell in booths seven days; all that are Israelites born shall dwell in booths.

And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever. (Rev 11:15)

The Book of Numbers

CHRIST IN THE TRIUNAL BLESSING Num. 6:24-26

The LORD bless thee, and keep thee: The LORD make his face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee: The LORD lift up his countenance upon thee, and give thee peace.

The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all. Amen. (2 Cor 13:14)

NONE OF HIS BONES WILL BE BROKEN Num. 9:12

They shall leave none of it unto the morning, nor break any bone of it: according to all the ordinances of the Passover they shall keep it.

The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the cross on the Sabbath day, (for that Sabbath day was an high day,) besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and that they might be taken away. Then came the soldiers, and brake the legs of the first, and of the other which was crucified with him. But when they came to Jesus, and saw that he was dead already, they brake not his legs: But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water. And he that saw it bare record, and his record is true: and he knoweth that he saith true, that ye might believe. For these things were done, that the scripture should be fulfilled, A bone of him shall not be broken. (John 19:31 36)

THE RED HEIFER A TYPE OF CHRIST Num. 19:1-2

And the LORD spake unto Moses and unto Aaron, saying, This is the ordinance of the law which the LORD hath commanded, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, that they bring thee a red heifer without spot, wherein is no blemish, and upon which never came yoke:

For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprin-

kling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh: How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? (Heb 9:13-14)

CHRIST OUR INTERCESSOR Num. 20:8-12

In Exodus 17 the Lord told Moses to smite the rock, a type of Christ which was

Smitten for our sin. In Numbers 21 God told Moses to speak to the rock. A type of Christ our intercessor.

And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, Take the rod, and gather thou the assembly together, thou, and Aaron thy brother, and speak ye unto the rock before their eyes; and it shall give forth his water, and thou shalt bring forth to them water out of the rock: so thou shalt give the congregation and their beasts drink.' And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also. And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron, Because ye believed me not, to sanctify me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore ye shall not bring this congregation into the land which I have given them.

And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ. (1 Cor 10:4)

THE SERPENT ON THE POLE A TYPE OF CHRIST Num. 21:9

And Moses made a serpent of brass, and put it upon a pole, and it came to pass, that if a serpent had bitten any man, when he beheld the serpent of brass, he lived.

And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up: That whosoever believeth in him should

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not perish, but have eternal life. For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. (John 3:14 18)

- The Serpent as a type of Christ for the following:
- The brass serpent had the same shape as of the fiery serpent but without the poison just as Jesus who took our body but without our sinful nature.
- The only way for salvation was through the serpent, just as Jesus is the only way for salvation
- Healing occurred just by looking at the serpent by faith. Look and live, and salvation is just by looking at Jesus by faith and believing "Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else." (Isa 45:22).
- The serpent was lifted up high upon a rod, Jesus was lifted up high upon the Cross." And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all men unto me."(John 12:32).
- The serpent was not hidden in a corner, but it was amidst the people for all to see, Jesus was crucified high upon the hill of Golgotha for all to see.
- The person who was bitten was bound to die if he did not look at the brass serpent, similarly all sinners shall die if they do not look to Jesus by faith.
- The healing of each person who looks upon the serpent is personal and not a collective act, each person should take Jesus as personal savior.

A STAR OUT OF JACOB Num. 24:17

I shall see him, but not now: I shall behold him, but not nigh: there shall come a Star out of Jacob, and a Scepter shall rise out of Israel, and shall smite the corners of Moab, and destroy all the children of Seth.

We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts: (2 Pet 1:19)

I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star. (Rev 22:16)

The Book of Deuteronomy

A Prophet like unto Moses Deu. 18:15 16

The LORD thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken; According to all that thou desire of the LORD thy God in Horeb in the day of the assembly, saying, Let me not hear again the voice of the LORD my God, neither let me see this great fire any more, that I die not.

This is that Moses, which said unto the children of Israel, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye hear. (Acts 7:37)

Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father: there is one that accuseth you, even Moses, in whom ye trust. For had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed me: for he wrote of me. But if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe my words? (John 5:45 47)

I WILL PUT MY WORDS IN HIS MOUTH Deu. 18:18

I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him.

For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father which sent me, he gave me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak And I know that his commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto me, so I speak. (John 12:49-50).

PROPHET LIKE UNTO MOSES (A JEW) Deu. 18:18

I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him.

Wherefore in all things it behooved him to be made like unto his

brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people. (Heb 2:17)

HIS WORD SHOULD BE OBEYED Deu. 18:19

And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto my words which he shall speaking my name, I will require it of him.

He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day. (John 12:48)

CHRIST BECAME A CURSE FOR US Deu. 21:23

His body shall not remain all night upon the tree, but thou shalt in any wise bury him that day; (for he that is hanged is accursed of God;) that thy land be not defiled, which the LORD thy God giveth thee for an inheritance.

For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them. But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The just shall live by faith. And the law is not of faith: but, The man that doeth them shall live in them. Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: (Gal 3:10 13)

The Book of Joshua

JOSHUA SYMBOLIZES CHRIST IN HIS NAME (GOD SAVES) Josh. 1:1-2

Moses represents the law and after him came Joshua who represents grace. Moses and his law failed to get the people into the Land of Canaan. Joshua came and lead them in.

Now after the death of Moses the servant of the LORD it came to pass, that the LORD spake unto Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' minister, saying: Moses my servant is dead; now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, thou, and all this people, unto the land which I do give to them, even to the children of Israel.

For if Jesus had given them rest, then would he not afterward have spoken of another day. (Heb 4:8)

THE SCARLET CORD IS A TYPE OF CHRIST'S BLOOD Josh. 2:18

Behold, when we come into the land, thou shalt bind this line of scarlet thread in the window which thou didst let us down by: and thou shalt bring thy father, and thy mother, and thy brethren, and all thy father's household, home unto thee.

And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house. (Acts 16:31)

THE ARK OF COVENANT IS A TYPE OF CHRIST LEADING THE PEOPLE Josh. 3:2, 11

And it came to pass after three days, that the officers went through the host; Behold, the ark of the covenant of the LORD of all the earth passeth over before you into Jordan.

From that time forth began Jesus to show unto his disciples, how that he must go unto Jerusalem, and suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised again the third day. (Mat 16:21)

CHRIST IS THE CAPTAIN OF OUR FAITH Josh. 5:13 62

And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted up his eyes and looked, and, behold, there stood a man over against him with his sword drawn in his hand: and Joshua went unto him, and said unto him, Art thou for us, or for our adversaries? And he said, Nay; but as captain of the host of the LORD am I now come. And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, and did worship, and said unto him, What saith my lord unto his servant? And the captain of the LORD'S host said unto Joshua, Loose thy shoe from off thy foot; for the place whereon thou standest is holy. And Joshua did so.

Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Sion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believeth on him shall not be confounded. (1 Pet 2:6)

Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. (Heb 12:2)

Joshua interceded for the people when they sinned Josh. 7:1 7

O Lord, what shall I say, when Israel turneth their backs before their enemies! For the Canaanites and all the inhabitants of the land shall hear of it, and shall environ us round, and cut off our name from the earth: and what wilt thou do unto thy great name? And the LORD said unto Joshua, Get thee up; wherefore liest thou thus upon thy face? Israel hath sinned, and they have also transgressed my covenant which I commanded them: for they have even taken of the accursed thing, and have also stolen, and dissembled also, and they have put it even among their own stuff. Therefore the children of Israel could not stand before their enemies, but turned their backs before their enemies,

The Book of Joshua

because they were accursed: neither will I be with you any more, except ye destroy the accursed from among you.

Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them. (Heb 7:25)

My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous: And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world. (1 John 2:1 2)

If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:8 9)

THE CITIES OF REFUGE TYPE OF CHRIST Josh. 20:7-8

The cities of refuge are six in number. Number six is an imperfect number. Christ is the seventh one. (Ps.73:28, 90:1, 91:2). All safe when inside. (Rom 8:1).

The MEANING OF THE NAMES of the cities of refuge as a type of Christ, our refuge.

KADESH: Means Holy. Christ is the refuge for the unholy sinners.

Shechem: Means Shoulder. (the center of power). Christ is the refuge for the powerless.

HEBRON: Means Fellowship and friendship. Christ is the refuge of friendship for those who are lonely.

BEZER: Means Fort. Christ is the fort for those who have no strength.

RAMOTH: Means High and glorified. Christ is the glory for those who are lowly and meek.

GOLAN: Means Stranger or traveler. Christ is the refuge for those who are strangers.

The Book of Judges

CHRIST IS WONDERFUL IN HIS NAME Judg. 13:18

And the Angel of the LORD said unto him," Why do you ask My name, seeing it is wonderful?"

And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins. Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us. (Mat 1:21-23)

The Book of Ruth

BOAZ A TYPE OF CHRIST AS THE KINSMAN REDEEMER Ruth 2:1

And Naomi had a kinsman of her husband's, a mighty man of wealth, of the family of Elimelech; and his name was Boaz.

And Salmon begat Booz of Rachab; and Booz begat Obed of Ruth; and Obed begat Jesse; (Mat 1:5)

Boaz is a type of Christ for the followings;

- 1) In his name :Boaz's name means "In him is strength". (Matt. 1:21)
- 2) Boaz was a kinsman with the right to redeem Ruth. Christ became our kinsman that He might redeem the Church. (Heb 2:14,17)
- 3) Boaz was rich and able to redeem Ruth. Christ was rich and able to redeem the Church. (2 Cor. 8:9) 4) Boaz was not only able, but also willing to redeem Ruth. Christ was willing and able to redeem the Church. (Mark 10:45)
- 5) Boaz was the lord of the harvest. Christ also is the LORD of the harvest. (Matt. 9:37)

The Book of First Samuel

CHRIST THE ANOINTED ONE 1 Sam. 2:10

The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken to pieces; out of heaven shall he thunder upon them: the LORD shall judge the ends of the earth; and he shall give strength unto his king, and exalt the horn of his anointed, (meaning Christ).

And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. (Mat 28:18)

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, (Luke 4:18)

The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham. (Mat 1:1)

Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh; (Rom 1:3)

I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star. (Rev 22:16)

He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David: And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end. (Luke 1:32-33)

CHRIST THE SIN BEARER 2 Sam. 12:13

And David said unto Nathan, I have sinned against the LORD. And Nathan said unto David, The LORD also hath put away thy sin; thou shalt not die.

In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. (Col 2:3)

CHRIST GREATER THAN SOLOMON 1 Ki. 10:5 8

And the meat of his table, and the sitting of his servants, and the attendance of his ministers, and their apparel, and his cupbearers, and his ascent by which he went up unto the house of the LORD; there was no more spirit in her. And she said to the king, It was a true report that I heard in mine own land of thy acts and of thy wisdom. For thus saith the LORD, Ye shall not see wind, neither shall ye see rain; yet that valley shall be filled with water, that ye may drink, both ye, and your cattle, and your beasts. And it came to pass in the morning, when the meat offering was offered, that, behold, there came water by the way of Edom, and the country was filled with water.

In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace. (Eph 1:7)

SOLOMON A TYPE OF CHRIST. 1Chr. 17:13-14

I will be his father, and he shall be my son: and I will not take my mercy away from him, as I took it from him that was before thee: But I will settle him in mine house and in my kingdom for ever: and his throne shall be established for evermore. THE SACRIFICE OF CHRIST FOR ATONEMENT IS SEEN Ezra 3:3-5

Fear was upon them because of the people of those countries: and they offered burnt offerings thereon unto the LORD, even burnt offerings morning and evening. They kept also the feast of tabernacles, as it is written, and offered the daily burnt offerings by number, according to the custom, as the duty of every day required; And afterward offered the continual burnt offering, both of the new moons, and of all the set feasts of the LORD that were consecrated, and of every one that willingly offered a freewill offering unto the LORD.

And they set the altar upon his bases; for The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world. (John 1:29)

THE PASSOVER LAMB IS MAINTAINED Ezra 6:19

And the children of the captivity kept the Passover upon the fourteenth day of the first month.

Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us. (1 Cor 5:7)

SIN OFFERING IS A TYPE OF CHRIST Ezra 8:35

Also the children of those that had been carried away, which were come out of the captivity, offered burnt offerings unto the God of Israel, twelve bullocks for all Israel, ninety and six rams, seventy and seven lambs, twelve he goats for a sin offering: all this was a burnt offering unto the LORD.

For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him. (2 Cor 5:21)

The Book of Neiamiah

CHRIST FULFILLED THE URIM AND THUMMIM (THE PREFECT REVEALING LIGHT) FOR CHRIST IS THE TRUE LIGHT Neh. 7:63-65

And of the priests: the children of Habaiah, the children of Koz, the children of Barzillai, which took one of the daughters of Barzillai the Gileadite to wife, and was called after their name. These sought their register among those that were reckoned by genealogy, but it was not found: therefore were they, as polluted, put from the priesthood. And the Tirshatha said unto them, that they should not eat of the most holy things, till there stood up a priest with Urim and Thummim.

That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world. (John 1:9)

Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life. (John 8:12)

The Book of Esther

ESTHER WAS WILLING TO DIE TO REDEEM HER PEOPLE. IN THE SAME MANNER CHRIST WAS WILLING TO DIE TO SAVE ALL WHO BELIEVE ON HIM. Esth. 4:15-16

Then Esther bade them return Mordecai this answer, Go, gather together all the Jews that are present in Shushan, and fast ye for me, and neither eat nor drink three days, night or day: I also and my maidens will fast likewise; and so will I go in unto the king, which is not according to the law: and if I perish, I perish. Now it came to pass on the third day, that Esther put on her royal apparel, and stood in the inner court of the king's house, over against the king's house: and the king sat upon his royal throne in the royal house, over against the gate of the house. And it was so, when the king saw Esther the queen standing in the court, that she obtained favor in his sight: and the king held out to Esther the golden scepter that was in his hand. So Esther drew near, and touched the top of the scepter.

Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again. No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father. (John 10:17-18)

The Book of Job

CHRIST OUR INTERCESSOR Job 9:32-33

For he is not a man, as I am, that I should answer him, and we should come together in judgment. Neither is there any daysman betwixt us, that might lay his hand upon us both.

And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven. (Col 1:20)

CHRIST THE LIVING REDEEMER Job 19:25-27

For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth: And though after my skin worms destroy this body, yet in my flesh shall I see God: Whom I shall see for myself, and mine eyes shall behold, and not another; though my reins be consumed within me.

Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life. CHRIST THE MESSENGER AMONG TEN THOUSAND Job 33:23-24

If there be a messenger with him, an interpreter, one among a thousand, to show unto man his uprightness: Then he is gracious unto him, and saith, Deliver him from going down to the pit: I have found a ransom.

For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus. (1 Tim 2:5)

CHRIST THE RANSOM Job 33:24

Then he is gracious unto him, and saith, Deliver him from going down to the pit: I have found a ransom.

The Book of Psalms

THE CONSPIRACY AGAINST CHRIST Ps. 2:1 3

Why do the heathen rage, and the people imagine a vain thing? The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD, and against his anointed, saying, Let us break their bands asunder, and cast away their cords from us.

Who by the mouth of thy servant David hast said, Why did the heathen rage, and the people imagine vain things? The kings of the earth stood up, and the rulers were gathered together against the Lord, and against his Christ. For of a truth against thy holy child Jesus, whom thou hast anointed, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together, For to do whatsoever thy hand and thy counsel determined before to be done. The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD, and against his anointed, saying,

Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ. (Acts 2:36)

CHRIST THE KING Ps. 2:6

Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion.

And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads. (Rev 14:1)

Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him. (Mat 2:2)

The Eternal Son of God Ps. 2:7

I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto me, Thou art my Son; this day have I begotten thee.

God hath fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that he hath raised up Jesus again; as it is also written in the second psalm, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee. (Acts 13:33)

ALL POWER IS GIVEN TO HIM Ps. 2:8

Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession.

And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. (Mat 28:18)

KISS THE SON, THE KISS OF ACCEPTANCE Ps. 2:12

Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and ye perish from the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put their trust in him.

But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name. (John 1:12)

THE WRATH OF THE SON Ps. 2:12

Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and ye perish from the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put their trust in him.

And said to the mountains and rocks, fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb: For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand? (Rev 6:16-17)

BLESSED ARE THEY WHO BELIEVE ON HIM Ps. 2:12

Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and ye perish from the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put

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their trust in him.

He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him. (John 3:36)

EVEN THE SUCKLING WILL GIVE PRAISE UNTO HIM Ps. 8:2

Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings hast thou ordained strength because of thine enemies, that thou mightiest still the enemy and the avenger.

And said unto him, Hearest thou what these say? And Jesus saith unto them, Yea; have ye never read, Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings thou hast perfected praise? (Mat 21:16)

HIS HUMILIATION AND EXALTATION Ps. 8:5 6

For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honor. Thou madest him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all things under his feet.

But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honor; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man. (Heb 2:9)

HIS BODY WILL NOT SEE CORRUPTION Ps. 16:10

For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.

He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption. This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses. Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear. For David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself, The Lord said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand. (Acts 2:31 34)

And we declare unto you glad tidings, how that the promise which was made unto the fathers, God hath fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that he hath raised up Jesus again; as it is also written in the second psalm, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee. And as concerning that he raised him up from the dead, now no more to return to corruption, he said on this wise, I will give you the sure mercies of David. Wherefore he saith also in another psalm, Thou shalt not suffer thine Holy One to see corruption. For David, after he had served his own generation by the will of God, fell on sleep, and was laid unto his fathers, and saw corruption: But he, whom God raised again, saw no corruption. Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins: (Acts 13:32 38)

THE SUFFERING SHEPHERD Ps. 22:1

My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? why art thou so far from helping me, and from the words of my roaring?

And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? (Mat 27:46)

And at the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani? which is, being interpreted, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? (Mark 15:34)

HE WAS DESPISED Ps. 22:6

But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised of the people.

Thou madest him a little lower than the angels; thou crownedst him with glory and honor, and didst set him over the works of thy hands: But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honor; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man. (Heb 2:7,9)

THE BOOK OF PSALMS

THE MOCKING OF THE CRUCIFIED Ps. 22:7

All they that see me laugh me to scorn: they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying:

And they that passed by reviled him, wagging their heads. (Mat 27:39)

HE TRUSTED IN GOD Ps. 22:8

He trusted on the LORD that he would deliver him: let him deliver him, seeing he delighted in him.

He trusted in God; let him deliver him now, if he will have him: for he said, I am the Son of God. (Mat 27:43)

THE BULLS OF BASHON (THE JEWS) WERE AGAINST HIM Ps. 22:12 13

Many bulls have compassed me: strong bulls of Bashan have beset me round. They gaped upon me with their mouths, as a ravening and a roaring lion.

Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know: Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and by wicked hands have crucified and slain: (Acts 2:22-23)

HIS AGONY ON THE CROSS Ps. 22:14

I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint: my heart is like wax; it is melted in the midst of my bowels.

But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water. (John 19:34)

HIS SEVERE THIRST Ps. 22:15

My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and my tongue

cleaveth to my jaws; and Thou hast brought me into the dust of death. Ps. 22:15

After this, Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled, saith, I thirst. (John 19:28)

FOR DOGS (GENTILES) HAVE COMPASSED ME Ps. 22:16

For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have enclosed me: they pierced my hands and my feet.

But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water. (John 19:34)

HIS PIERCED HANDS AND FEET Ps. 22:16

For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have enclosed me: they pierced my hands and my feet.

And when they were come to the place, which is called Calvary, there they crucified him, and the malefactors, one on the right hand, and the other on the left. (Luke 23:33)

HIS SEVERE AGONY Ps. 22:17

I may tell all my bones: they look and stare upon me.

Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots. And the people stood beholding. And the rulers also with them derided him, saying, He saved others; let him save himself, if he be Christ, the chosen of God. (Luke 23:34 35)

CASTING LOT ON HIS GARMENT Ps. 22:18

They part my garments among them, and cast lots upon my vesture.

Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took his garments, and made four parts, to every soldier a part; and also his coat: now the coat was without seam, woven from the top throughout.

THE BOOK OF PSALMS

They said therefore among themselves, Let us not rend it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be: that the scripture might be fulfilled, which saith, They parted my raiment among them, and for my vesture they did cast lots. These things therefore the soldiers did. (John 19:23 24)

HIS AGONY FROM BOTH JEWS AND GENTILES Ps. 22:20 21

Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; (Heb 2:14)

HIS RESURRECTION IS PREDICTED Ps. 22:22

Deliver my soul from the sword; my darling from the power of the dog. Save Me from the lion's mouth; for thou hast heard me from the horn of the unicorn.

Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and to my God, and your God. (John 20:17)

THE GENTILES WILL BELIEVE ON HIM Ps. 22:27

All the ends of the world shall remember and turn unto the LORD: and all the kindred of the nations shall worship before thee.

Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: (Mat 28:19)

All those who go down to dust shall bow before Him Ps. 22:29

All they that be fat upon earth shall eat and worship: all they that go down to the dust shall bow before him: and none can keep alive his own soul.

That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; (Phil 2:10).

THE JOB WAS COMPLETED Ps. 22:31

They shall come, and shall declare his righteousness unto a people that shall be born, that he hath done this. (He hath finished the work.. It is finished).

When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost. (John 19:30)

CHRIST THE GOOD SHEPHERD Ps. 23:1

The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep. (John 10:11)

THE GREAT SHEPHERD RESTORES AND LEADS HIS SHEEP FOR HIS NAME SAKE Ps. 23:3

He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. (John 10:27-28)

THE GLORIFIED KING (THE CHIEF SHEPHERD) Ps. 24:7

Lift up your heads, O ye gates; and be ye lift up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in.

And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away. (1 Pet 5:4)

THE GOOD TEACHER Ps. 25:8

Good and upright is the LORD: therefore will he teach sinners in the way.

And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at his doctrine:

For he taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes. (Mat 7:28-29)

HE IS THE LORD, MY SALVATION Ps. 27:1

The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved. (Acts 4:12)

THE LORD IS MY ROCK Ps. 27:5

For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock.

And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ. (1 Cor 10:4)

THE RESURRECTION OF CHRIST IS SEEN Ps. 30:3

O LORD, thou hast brought up my soul from the grave: thou hast kept me alive, that I should not go down to the pit.

This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses. (Acts 2:32)

HE COMMITTED HIS SPIRIT TO THE FATHER Ps. 31:5

Into thine hand I commit my spirit; thou hast redeemed me, O Lord God of truth.

And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost. (Luke 23:46)

HIS ACQUAINTANCE FLED FROM HIM Ps. 31:11

I was a reproach among all mine enemies, but especially among my neighbours, and a fear to mine acquaintance: they that did see me without fled from me.

And Jesus answered and said unto them, Are ye come out, as against a thief, with swords and with staves to take me? I was daily with you in the temple teaching, and ye took me not: but the scriptures must be fulfilled. And they all forsook him, and fled. (Mark 14:48-50)

THEY TOOK COUNSEL TO TAKE HIS LIFE Ps. 31:13

For I have heard the slander of many: fear was on every side: while they took counsel together against me, they devised to take away my life.

Then from that day forth they took counsel together for to put him to death. (John 11:53)

None of His Bones will be Broken P. 34:20

He keepeth all his bones: not one of them is broken.

The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the cross on the Sabbath day, (for that Sabbath day was an highday,) besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and that they might be taken away. Then came the soldiers, and brake the legs of the first, and of the other which was crucified with him. But when they came to Jesus, and sawt hat he was dead already, they brake not his legs: But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water. And he that saw it bare record, and his record is true: and he knoweth that he saith true, that ye might believe. For these things were done, that the scripture should be fulfilled, A bone of him shall not be broken. (John 19:31-36)

FALSE WITNESSES WERE AGAINST HIM Ps. 35:11 12

False witnesses did rise up; they laid to my charge things that I knew not. They rewarded me evil for good to the spoiling of my soul.

Now the chief priests, and elders, and all the council, sought false witness against Jesus, to put him to death; (Mat 26:59)

HATED WITHOUT A CAUSE Ps. 35:19

Let not them that are mine enemies wrongfully rejoice over me: neither let them wink with the eye that hate me without a cause.

But this cometh to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They hated me without a cause. (John 15:25)

HIS FRIENDS STOOD AFAR OFF Ps. 38:11 12

My lovers and my friends stand aloof from my sore; and my kinsmen stand afar off. They also that seek after my life lay snares for me: and they that seek my hurt speak mischievous things, and imagine deceits all the day long.

And all his acquaintance, and the women that followed him from Galilee, stood afar off, beholding these things. (Luke 23:49)

HE OPENED NOT HIS MOUTH Ps. 38:13 14

But I, as a deaf man, heard not; and I was as a dumb man that openeth not his mouth. Thus I was as a man that heareth not, and in whose mouth are no reproofs.

And Pilate asked him again, saying, Answerest thou nothing? behold how many things they witness against thee. But Jesus yet answered nothing; so that Pilate marvelled. (Mark 15:45)

Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously: (1 Pet 2:22 23)

CHRIST IS THE ROCK Ps. 40:2 5

He brought me up also out of an horrible pit. Out of the miry clay, and set my feet Upon a rock, and established my going. And he hath put a new song in my Mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the Lord.

And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ. (1 Cor 10:4)

HE CAME TO DO THE WILL OF THE FATHER Ps. 40:6 8

Sacrifice and offering thou didst not desire; mine ears thou opened: burnt

Offering and sin offering hast thou not required, then said I, Lo, I come: In the volume of the book it is written of me, I delight to do thy will, O God: yea, thy law is within my heart.

Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O God. (Heb, 10:7)

HE PREACHED RIGHTEOUSNESS TO THE PEOPLE Ps. 40:9-10

I have preached righteousness in the great congregation: lo, I have not refrained my lips, O LORD, thou knowest. I have not hid thy righteousness within my heart; I have declared thy faithfulness and thy salvation: I have not concealed thy loving-kindness and thy truth from the great congregation.

For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren, Saying, I will declare thy name unto my brethren, in the midst of the church will I sing praise unto thee. (Heb 2:12)

HIS FRIEND HAS LIFTED HIS HEEL AGAINST HIM Ps. 41:9

Yea, mine own familiar friend, in whom I trusted, which did eat of my bread, hath lifted up his heel against me.

I speak not of you all: I know whom I have chosen: but that the scripture may be fulfilled, He that eateth bread with me hath lifted up his heel against me. (John 13:18)

HE SPOKE WITH GRACIOUS WORD Ps. 45:2

Thou art fairer than the children of men: grace is poured into thy lips: therefore God hath blessed thee for ever.

And all bare him witness, and wondered at the gracious words which proceeded out of his mouth. And they said, Is not this Joseph's son? (Luke 4:22)

TO HIM WAS SAID THY THRONE O GOD Ps. 45:6

Thy throne, O God is forever and ever: the scepter of thy kingdom is a right forever.

But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a scepter of righteousness is the scepter of thy kingdom. (Heb 1:8)

Anointed by the Holy Spirit Ps. 45:7

Thou lovest righteousness, and hatest wickedness: therefore God, thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.

For of a truth against thy holy child Jesus, whom thou hast anointed, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together, (Acts 4:27)

Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows. (Heb 1:9)

CHRIST IS COMING AS A JUDGE Ps. 50:3 5

Our God shall come, and shall not keep silence: a fire shall devour before him. And it shall be very tempestuous round about him, He shall call to the Heavens from above, and to the earth. That he may judge his people. Gather My saints together unto me; those have made a covenant with me by Sacrifice.

And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. (Mat 24:30)

BETRAYED BY HIS FRIEND AND NOT AN ENEMY Ps. 55:12 14

For it is not an enemy that reproached me; then I could have borne it: neither was it he that hated me that did magnify himself against me; then I would have hid myself from him; But it was thou, a man mine equal, my guide, and mine acquaintance. We took swett counsel together, and walked unto the house of God in company.

I speak not of you all: I know whom I have chosen: but that the scripture may be fulfilled, He that eateth bread with me hath lifted up his heel against me. (John 13:18)

CHRIST STILLS THE STORM Ps. 65:7

Which stilleth the noise of the seas, the noise of their waves, and the tumult of the people.

And he saith unto them, Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith? Then he arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm. (Mat 8:26)

CHRIST'S ASCENSION IS FORETOLD Ps. .68:18

Thou hast ascended on high.

And it came to pass, while he blessed them, he was parted from them, and carried up into heaven. (Luke 24:51)

GAVE GIFTS TO MEN Ps. 68:18

Thou hast ascended on high, thou hast led captivity captive: thou hast received gifts for men; yea, for the rebellious also, that the LORD God might dwell among them.

But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ. Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men. (Now that he ascended, what is it but that he also descended first into the lower parts of the earth? He that descended is the same also that ascended up far above all heavens, that he might fill all things.) And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: (Eph 4:4-12)

HIS SEVERE THIRST ON THE CROSS Ps. 69:3

I am weary of my crying: my throat is dried: mine eyes fail while I wait for my God.

And straightway one of them ran, and took a sponge, and filled it with vinegar, and put it on a reed, and gave him to drink. (Matt 27:48)

HATED WITHOUT A CAUSE Ps. 69:4

They that hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of mine head: they that would destroy me, being mine enemies wrongfully, are mighty: then I restored that which I took not away.

But this cometh to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They hated me without a cause. (John 15:25)

Became stranger to His Brethren Ps. 69:8

I am become a stranger unto my brethren, and an alien unto my mother's children.

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And it was told him by certain which said, Thy mother and thy brethren stand without, desiring to see thee. And he answered and said unto them, My mother and my brethren are these which hear the word of God, and do it. (Luke 8:20 21)

BECAME ZEALOUS FOR HIS HOUSE Ps. 69:9

For the zeal of thine house hath eaten me up; and the reproaches of them that reproached thee are fallen upon me.

And his disciples remembered that it was written, The zeal of thine house hath eaten me up. (John 2:17)

NO ONE CARES FOR HIS SOUL Ps. 69:20

Reproach hath broken my heart; and I am full of heaviness: and I looked for some to take pity, but there was none; and for comforters, but I found none.

Then saith he unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death: tarry ye here, and watch with me. (Mat 26:38)

GIVEN VINEGAR IN HIS THIRST Ps. 69:21

They gave me also gall for my meat; and in my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink.

They gave him vinegar to drink mingled with gall: and when he had tasted thereof, he would not drink. (Mat 27:34)

The end of those who have betrayed Him Ps. 69:25

Let their habitation be desolate; and let none dwell in their tents.

For it is written in the book of Psalms, Let his habitation be desolate, and let no man dwell therein: and his bishopric let another take. Wherefore of these men which have companied with us all the time that the Lord Jesus went in and out among us, Beginning from the baptism of John, unto that same day that he was taken up from

us, must one be ordained to be a witness with us of his resurrection. And they appointed two, Joseph called Barsabas, who was surnamed Justus, and Matthias. (Acts 1:20 23)

CHRIST'S KINGDOM FORETOLD Ps. 72:8

He shall have dominion also from sea to sea, and from the river unto the ends of the earth.

And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS. (Rev 19:15-16)

KINGS WILL COME AND PAY HIM HOMAGE AND BRING GIFTS Ps. 72:10

HIS NAME WILL BE KNOWN FOREVER Ps. 72:17

His name shall endure for ever: his name shall be continued as long as the sun: and men shall be blessed in him: all nations shall call him blessed.

Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. (Phil 2:6 11)

HIS NAME SHALL BE A BLESSING TO ALL NATION Ps. 72:17

His name shall endure for ever: his name shall be continued as long as the sun: and men shall be blessed in him: all nations shall call him blessed.

Now when Jesus had heard that John was cast into prison, he departed into Galilee; And leaving Nazareth, he came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is upon the sea coast, in the borders of Zabulon and Nephthalim: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, The land of Zabulon, and the land of Nephthalim, by the way of the sea, beyond Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles; The people which sat in darkness saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up. From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand. (Mat 4:12 17)

THE PEOPLE WHO WALK IN DARKNESS HAVE SEEN GREAT LIGHT Isa. 9:2

The people that walked in darkness have seen a great light: they that dwell in the land of the shadow of death, upon them hath the light shined.

To give light to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace. (Luke 1:79)

And all bare him witness, and wondered at the gracious words which proceeded out of his mouth. And they said, Is not this Joseph's son? (Luke 4:22)

His pre-existence:

For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. (John 1:1)

For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him: 17 And he is before all things, and by him all things consist. (Col 1:16 17)

Whose are the fathers, and of whom as concerning the flesh Christ came, who is over all, God blessed for ever. Amen. (Romans 9:5)

Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high; (Heb. 1:3)

But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting. (Micah 5:2)

His virgin birth:

Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel. (Isa. 7:14)

His name:

His name shall be forever before the sun, and all the nations shall be *blessed by His name*.

All prayers are answered through His name.

The sins are forgiven in His name,

There is no other name given under heaven by which we can be saved, (Judges 13:18; Isaiah 26:8; Psalm 72:17 Act 4:12)

His life:

The famous essay, "One Solitary Life" gives one of the best description of His life. It states:

Here is a man who was born in an obscure village, the child of a peasant woman. He grew up in another village, He worked in a carpenter shop until He was thirty, and then for three years He was an itinerant preacher. He never owned a home. He never wrote a book. He never held and office. He never had a family. He

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never went to college. He never put His foot inside a big city. He never traveled two hundred miles from the place where He was born. He never did one of the things that usually accompany greatness. He had no credentials but Himself.... While still a young man, the tide of popular opinion turned against Him. His friends ran away. One of them denied Him. He was turned over to His enemies. He went through the mockery of a trial. He was nailed upon a cross. between two thieves. While He was dying His executers gambled for the only piece of property He had on earth-His coat. When He was dead, He was taken down and laid in a borrowed grave through the pity of a friend.

Nineteen long centuries have come and gone and today He is the centerpiece of the human race and the leader of the column of progress. I am far within the mark when I say that all the armies that ever marched, all the navies that ever were built; all the parliaments that ever sat and all the kings that ever reigned, put together, have not affected the life of a man upon this earth as powerfully as has that one solitary life."

Another beautiful essay entitled "The Incomparable Christ,"

"More than nineteen hundred years ago there was a man born contrary to the laws of life. This man lived in poverty and was reared in obscurity. He did not travel extensively. Only once did He cross the boundary of the country in which He lived; that was during His exile in childhood.

He possessed neither wealth nor influence. His relatives were inconspicuous, and had neither training nor normal education. In infancy He startled a King; in childhood, He puzzled doctors; in manhood He ruled the course of nature by walking upon the billows as if pavements, and hushed the sea to sleep. He healed the multitudes without medicine and made no charge for His service.

He never wrote a book, and yet all the libraries of the country

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could not hold the books that were written about Him. He never wrote a song, and yet He has furnished the theme for more songs than all the songwriter combined.

He never founded a college, but all the schools put together cannot boast of having as many students.

He never marshaled and army, nor drafted any soldier, nor fired a gun; and yet no leader had ever had more volunteers who have under His orders, made more rebels stack arms and surrender without a shot fired.

He never practiced psychiatry, and yet He has healed more broken hearts than all the doctors far and near. Once a week the wheels of commerce cease their turning and multitudes wend their way to worshipping assemblies to pay homage and respect to Him.

The names of the past proud statesmen of Greece and Rome have come and gone. The names of the past scientists, philosophers, and theologians have come and gove; but the name of this man abounds more and more. Though time has spread nineteen hundred years between the people of this generation and the scene of His crucifixion, yet He still lives. Herod could not destroy Him, and the grave could not hold Him.

He stands forth upon the highest pinnacle of heavenly glory, proclaimed of God, acknowledged by angels, adored by saints, and feared by devils, as the living, personal Christ, our Lord and Savior."

His power:

He stood before sickness and subdued all its powers. The blind could see, the death would come back to life, the son of the widow of Nain, and Lazarus were raised up. As the father has authority over death so did the son (john 5:21) when he was in

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the sea with his disciples he rebuked the wind and the sea and restored peace (Luke 8:25)

The prophetic testimonies:

All prophets testify that whosoever believeth in his name shall have everlasting life. (Acts 10:43).

His resurrection:

All the prophets have died and their graves are still around it testifies of their death, albeit Jesus' grave is empty, he has risen. For the tomb in which he was buried could not hold him. For he is the resurrection and the life.

And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last: (Revelation 1:17)

THE TRINITY IS SEEN Isa. 48:16

Come ye near unto me, hear ye this; I have not spoken in secret from the beginning; from the time that it was, there AM I: and now the Lord GOD, and HIS SPIRIT, hath sent ME.

And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God. (Luke 1:35)

THE CHARACTER OF CHRIST Isa. 49:1

Listen, O isles, unto me; and hearken, ye people, from far; The LORD hath called me from the womb; from the bowels of my mother hath he made mention of my name.

Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost. (Mat. 1:18)

A LIGHT TO THE GENTILES Isa. 49:6

And he said, It is a light thing that thou shouldest be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel: I will also give thee for a light to the Gentiles, that thou

mayest be my salvation unto the end of the earth.

A light to lighten the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel. (Luke 2:32)

Delivering thee from the people, and from the Gentiles, unto whom now I send thee, To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me. (Acts 26:17-18)

THE REDEEMER DESPISED Isa. 49:7

Thus saith the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel, and his Holy One, to him whom man despiseth, to him whom the nation abhorreth, to a servant of rulers, Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of the LORD that is faithful, and the Holy One of Israel, and he shall choose thee.

Then answered the Jews, and said unto him, Say we not well that thou art a Samaritan, and hast a devil? (John 8:48)

THE LORD'S HAND IS NOT SHORTENED TO SAVE Isa. 50:2

Wherefore, when I came, was there no man? when I called, was there none to answer? Is my hand shortened at all, that it cannot redeem? or have I no power to deliver? behold, at my rebuke I dry up the sea, I make the rivers a wilderness: their fish stinketh, because there is no water, and dieth for thirst.

Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them. (Heb 7:25)

HIS WORD WILL GIVE COMFORT Isa. 50:4

The Lord GOD hath given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to him that is weary: he wakeneth morning by morning, he wakeneth mine ear

to hear as the learned.

Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. (Mat. 11:28)

GAVE HIS BACK TO THE SMITERS Isa. 50:5 6

The Lord GOD hath opened mine ear, and I was not rebellious, neither turned away back. I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my face from shame and spitting.

Then released he Barabbas unto them: and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered him to be crucified. (Mat. 27:26)

And they spit upon him, and took the reed, and smote him on the head. (Mat. 27:30)

SET HIS FACE LIKE A FLINT TOWARD JERUSALEM Isa. 50:7

For the Lord GOD will help me; therefore shall I not be confounded: therefore have I set my face like a flint, and I know that I shall not be ashamed.

And it came to pass, when the time was come that he should be received up, he steadfastly set his face to go to Jerusalem, (Luke 9:51)

CHRIST'S RIGHTEOUSNESS IS NEAR Isa. 51:5

My righteousness is near; my salvation is gone forth, and mine arms shall judge the people; the isles shall wait upon me, and on mine arm shall they trust.

But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach; That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. (Romans 10:8 9)

CHRIST THE COMFORTER Isa. 51:12

I, even I, am he that comforteth you: who art thou, that thou shouldest be afraid of a man that shall die, and of the son of man which shall be made as grass;

Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort. (2 Cor 1:3)

Publisher of good tidings Isa. 52:7

How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace; that bringeth good tidings of good, that publisheth salvation; that saith unto Zion, Thy God reigneth!

And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about. And he taught in their synagogues, being glorified of all. (Luke 4:14 15)

ALL FLESH SHALL SEE THE SALVATION OF GOD Isa. 52:10

The LORD hath made bare his holy arm in the eyes of all the nations; and all the ends of the earth shall see the salvation of our God.

And all flesh shall see the salvation of God. (Luke 3:6)

THE SUFFERING OF CHRIST ON THE CROSS Isa. 52:13-14

Behold, my servant shall deal prudently, he shall be exalted and extolled, and be very high. As many were astounded at thee; his visage was so marred more than any man, and his form more than the sons of men:

And they stripped him, and put on him a scarlet robe. And when they had platted a crown of thorns, they put it upon his head, and a reed in his right hand: and they bowed the knee before him, and mocked him, saying, Hail, King of the Jews! And they spit upon him, and took the reed, and smote him on the head. And after that they

had mocked him, they took the robe off from him, and put his own raiment on him, and led him away to crucify him (Mat. 27:28-31)

Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. (Phil 2:6 11)

The news about the substitutionary death of Christ is too good to be true Isa. 53:1

Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed?

But though he had done so many miracles before them, yet they believed not on him: That the saying of Esaias the prophet might be fulfilled, which he spake, Lord, who hath believed our report? and to whom hath the arm of the Lord been revealed? Therefore they could not believe, because that Esaias said again, He hath blinded their eyes, and hardened their heart; that they should not see with their eyes, nor understand with their heart, and be converted, and I should heal them. These things said Esaias, when he saw his glory, and spake of him. (John 12:37 41)

Christ is the root out of a dry ground Isa. 53:2

For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him.

Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know: Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and by wicked hands have crucified and slain: Whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that he should be holden of it. (Acts 2:22 24)

DESPISED AND REJECTED OF MEN Isa. 53:3

He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

He came unto his own, and his own received him not. (John 1:11)

Then answered the Jews, and said unto him, Say we not well that thou art a Samaritan, and hast a devil? (John 8:48)

CARRIED OUR GRIEVES AND SORROWS Isa. 53:4

Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses. (Mat. 8:17)

For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. (Heb 4:15)

Wounded for our transgression Isa. 53:5

But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven. (Col 1:20)

For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit. (1 Pet 3:18)

Then Pilate therefore took Jesus, and scourged him. (John 19:1) Ye know that after two days is the feast of the Passover, and the Son of man is betrayed to be crucified. (Mat. 26:2)

Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many. (Mat. 20:28)

BORE OUR INIQUITIES Isa. 53:6

All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

Who was delivered for our offences, and was raised again for our justification (Rom 4:25).

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; (Rom 3:23)

For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him. (2 Cor 5:21)

HIS MEEKNESS Isa. 53:7

He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. (Mat. 11:29)

LED AS A LAMB TO THE SLAUGHTER Isa. 53:7

And Pilate asked him, Art thou the King of the Jews? And he answering said unto him, Thou sayest it. And the chief priests accused him of many things: but he answered nothing. And Pilate asked him

again, saying, Answerest thou nothing? behold how many things they witness against thee. But Jesus yet answered nothing; so that Pilate marveled. (Mark 15:25)

HE OPENED NOT HIS MOUTH Isa. 53:7

And he answered him to never a word; insomuch that the governor marveled greatly. (Mat. 27:14)

CUT OFF FROM THE LAND OF THE LIVING Isa. 53:8

He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.

And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost. (Luke 23:46)

STRICKEN FOR THE TRANSGRESSION OF THE PEOPLE Isa. 53:8

And this spake he not of himself: but being high priest that year, he prophesied that Jesus should die for that nation; And not for that nation only, but that also he should gather together in one the children of God that were scattered abroad. (John 11:51 52)

HIS GRAVE WITH THE WICKED Isa. 53:9

And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth.

Then were there two thieves crucified with him, one on the right hand, and another on the left. (Mat. 27:38)

BURIED WITH THE RICH Isa. 53:9

When the even was come, there came a rich man of Arimathaea, named Joseph, who also himself was Jesus' disciple: He went to Pilate,

JESUS, THE CENTER OF PROPHECIES

and begged the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be delivered. And when Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, And laid it in his own new tomb, which he had hewn out in the rock: and he rolled a great stone to the door of the sepulcher, and departed. (Mat. 27:57 60)

HE DID NO WRONG Isa. 53:9

Then were there two thieves crucified with him, one on the right hand, and another on the left. (Mat. 27:38)

HIS SOUL WAS MADE AN OFFERING FOR SIN Isa. 53:10

Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.

He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things? (Rom 8:32)

HE WILL SEE ALL HIS SEED Isa. 53:10

Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit. (John 12:24)

HE WILL JUSTIFY MANY Isa. 53:11

He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.

Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life. For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous. (Rom 5:18 19)

Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins: And by him all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses. Beware therefore, lest that come upon you, which is spoken of in the prophets; Behold, ye despisers, and wonder, and perish: for I work a work in your days, a work which ye shall i no wise believe, though a man declare it unto you. (Acts 13:38 41)

HE SHALL BEAR THE INIQUITIES OF MANY Isa. 53:11

He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.

Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed. (1 Pet 2:24)

HE POURED OUT HIS SOUL UNTO DEATH Isa. 53:12

Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

As the Father knoweth me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down my life for the sheep. And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one fold, and one shepherd. Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again. No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father. (John 10:15 18)

JESUS, THE CENTER OF PROPHECIES

HE WAS NUMBERED WITH THE TRANSGRESSORS Isa. 53:12

And with him they crucify two thieves; the one on his right hand, and the other on his left. And the scripture was fulfilled, which saith, And he was numbered with the transgressors. (Mark 15:27 28)

HE BORE THE SIN OF MANY Isa. 53:12

For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins. (Mat. 26:28)

So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation. (Heb 9:28)

HE MADE INTERCESSION FOR THE WICKED Isa. 53:12

And Pilate gave sentence that it should be as they required. (Luke 23:24)

INVITATION TO COME TO HIM AND LIVE Isa. 55:3

Incline your ear, and come unto me: hear, and your soul shall live; and I will make an everlasting covenant with you, even the sure mercies of David.

Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life. (John 5:24)

HIS HOUSE IS THE HOUSE OF PRAYER Isa. 56:7

Even them will I bring to my holy mountain, and make them joyful in my house of prayer: their burnt offerings and their sacrifices shall be accepted upon mine altar; for mine house shall be called an house of prayer for all people.

And said unto them, It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves. (Mat. 21:13)

THE HOLY, DWELLS WITH THE HUMBLE Isa. 57:15

For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, (Luke 4:18)

HE MADE PEACE TO JEWS AND GENTILES Isa. 57:19

Peace, peace to him that is far off, and to him that is near, saith the LORD; and I will heal him.

And came and preached peace to you which were afar off, and to them that were nigh. (Eph 2:17)

THE REPAIRER OF THE BREACH Isa. 58:12

And they that shall be of thee shall build the old waste places: thou shalt raise up the foundations of many generations; and thou shalt be called, The repairer of the breach, The restorer of paths to dwell in.

But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ... For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us; Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace. (Eph. 2:13-15)

CHRIST THE INTERCESSOR Isa. 59:16

And he saw that there was no man, and wondered that there was no intercessor: therefore his arm brought salvation unto him; and his righteousness, it sustained him.

Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them. (Heb 7:25)

THE REDEEMER COMES OUT OF ZION Isa. 59:20

And the Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, saith the LORD.

And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob. (Rom 11:26)

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. (John 3:16)

CHRIST THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD Isa. 60:1

Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee. For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee.

And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfill all my will. Of this man's seed hath God according to his promise raised unto Israel a Savior, Jesus: (Acts 13:22 23)

HE WILL RULE AS KING AND PROSPER Jer. 23:5

Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.

JESUS, THE CENTER OF PROPHECIES

And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end. (Luke 1:33)

SHALL BE CALLED THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS Jer. 23:6

In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: (1 Cor 1:30)

HE WILL BE THE GOOD SHEPHERD Jer. 31:10

Hear the word of the LORD, O ye nations, and declare it in the isles afar off, and say, He that scattered Israel will gather him, and keep him, as a shepherd doth his flock.

I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep. (John 10:11)

HE WHO SCATTER ISRAEL WILL GATHER THEM Jer. 31:10

For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fullness of the Gentiles be come in. (Rom 11:25)

THE KILLING OF THE CHILDREN Jer. 31:15

Thus saith the LORD; A voice was heard in Ramah, lamentation, and bitter weeping; Rahel weeping for her children refused to be comforted for her children, because they were not.

Then Herod, when he saw that he was mocked of the wise men, was exceeding wroth, and sent forth, and slew all the children that were in Bethlehem, and in all the coasts thereof, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had diligently inquired of

THE BOOK OF JEREMIAH

the wise men. Then was fulfilled that which was spoken by Jeremy the prophet, saying, In Rama was there a voice heard, lamentation, and weeping, and great mourning, Rachel weeping for her children, and would not be comforted, because they are not. (Mat. 2:16 18)

A WOMAN SHALL COMPASS A MAN Jer. 31:22

How long wilt thou go about, O thou backsliding daughter? for the LORD hath created a new thing in the earth, A woman shall compass a man.

Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost. (Mat 1:18)

CHRIST WILL BRING A NEW COVENANT Jer. 31:31 33

Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah: Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which my covenant they brake, although I was an husband unto them, saith the LORD: But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.

But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises. For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second. For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah: Not according to the covenant that I made

with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord. For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people: And they shall not teach every man his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest. For I will be merciful to their unright-eousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more. In that he saith, A new covenant, he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old is ready to vanish away. (Heb 8:6 13)

A BRANCH OF RIGHTEOUSNESS Jer. 33:15

In those days, and at that time, will I cause the Branch of righteousness to grow up unto David; and he shall execute judgment and righteousness in the land.

And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS. He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David: And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end. (Luke 1:31 33)

THE REDEEMER IS THE LORD OF HOST Jer. 50:34

Their Redeemer is strong; the LORD of hosts is his name: he shall thoroughly plead their cause, that he may give rest to the land, and disquiet the inhabitants of Babylon.

And cried when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying, What city is like unto this great city! (Rev 18:18)

The Book of Lamentations

CHRIST IS THE SALVATION OF THE LORD Lam. 3:26

It is good that a man should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation of the LORD.

Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all, (As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were. Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be. (Rom 4:16 18)

HE IS REPROACHED Lam. 3:30

He giveth his cheek to him that smiteth him: he is filled full with reproach.

Then did they spit in his face, and buffeted him; and others smote him with the palms of their hands, (Mat. 26:67)

The Book of Ezekiel

CHRIST IS THE RIGHTFUL MAN Ezek. 21:27

I will overturn, overturn, it: and it shall be no more, until he come whose right it is; (In Moffatt translation it reads until the rightful man arrives) and I will give it him.

And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice. Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof?

And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation. (Rev 5:2,9)

CHRIST IS THE ONE WHO STOOD IN THE GAP Ezek. 22:30

And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.

And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon. And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon. CHRIST IS THE ONE SHEPHERD Ezek. 34:11-24

Seemeth it a small thing unto you to have eaten up the good pasture, but ye must tread down with your feet the residue of your pastures? and to have drunk of the deep waters, but ye must foul the residue with your feet? And as for my flock, they eat that which ye have trodden with your feet; and they drink that which ye have fouled with your feet. Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD unto them; Behold, I, even I, will judge between the fat cattle and between the lean cattle. Because ye have thrust with side and with shoulder, and pushed all the diseased with your horns, till ye have scattered them abroad; Therefore will I save my flock, and they shall no more be a prey; and I will judge between cattle and cattle. And I will set up one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them, even my servant David; he shall feed them, and he shall be their shepherd. And I the LORD will be their God, and my servant David a prince among them; I the LORD have spoken it.

And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one fold, and one shepherd. (John 10:16)

THE BLOOD OF CHRIST IS SHED.

(THE BLOOD IN THE SINGULAR FORM HERE) Ezek. 36:18

Wherefore I poured my fury upon them for the blood that they had shed upon the land, and for their idols wherewith they had polluted it:

And killed the Prince of life, whom God hath raised from the dead; whereof we are witnesses. (Acts 3:15)

CHRIST WILL PURIFY HIS PEOPLE Ezek. 6:25

Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you, and ye shall be clean: from all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you.

For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh:... For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people, (Heb 9:13,19)

Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. (Heb 10:22)

Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call. (Acts 2:38 39)

THE MILLENNIUM KINGDOM Ezek. 37:24

And David my servant shall be king over them; and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in my judgments, and observe my statutes, and do them.

THE BOOK OF EZEKIEL

And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one fold, and one shepherd. (John 10:16)

But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. (Mat. 9:36)

The Book of Daniel

CHRIST IS THE STONE Dan. 2:45

Forasmuch as thou sawest that the stone was cut out of the mountain without hands, and that it brake in pieces the iron, the brass, the clay, the silver, and the gold; the great God hath made known to the king what shall come to pass hereafter: and the dream is certain, and the interpretation thereof sure.

Jesus saith unto them, Did ye never read in the scriptures, The stone which the builders rejected, the same is become the head of the corner: this is the Lord's doing, and it is marvelous in our eyes? Therefore say I unto you, The kingdom of God shall be taken from you, and given to a nation bringing forth the fruits thereof. And whosoever shall fall on this stone shall be broken: but on whomsoever it shall fall, it will grind him to powder. (Mat 21:42 44)

CHRIST THE SON OF GOD Dan. 3:25

his head like the pure wool: his throne was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire. A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: thousand thousands ministered unto him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: the judgment was set, and the books were opened.

I beheld then because of the voice of the great words which the horn spake: I beheld even till the beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame. As concerning the rest of the beasts, they had their dominion taken away: yet their lives were prolonged for a season and time.

I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.

And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlestick.s

And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.

His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire.

And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters. And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp two edged sword: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength. (Rev 1:12-16)

CHRIST THE SON OF MAN Dan. 7:13

I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of

man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him.

And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. (Mat 24:30)

HE WILL MAKE RECONCILIATION FOR INIQUITY Dan. 9:24

Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.

And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;

To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. (2Cor 5:18-19)

TO MAKE AN END OF SIN Dan. 9:24

THE MESSIAH SHALL BE CUT OFF. Dan. 9:26

And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

Now Caiaphas was he, which gave counsel to the Jews, that it was expedient that one man should die for the people. (John 18:14)

Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost. (Mat 27:50)

Christ's death is not for Himself Dan. 9:26

THE RESURRECTION OF CHRIST IS SEEN Hosea 6:2

After two days will he revive us: in the third day he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight

This refers directly to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. Only through Him can those dead in sin, be "revived and live again in God's sight" potentially, when He arose, all in Him arose also.

THE BOOK OF HOSEA

And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures: (1 Cor 15:4)

And he said unto them, What things? And they said unto him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people: And how the chief priests and our rulers delivered him to be condemned to death, and have crucified him. But we trusted that it had been he which should have redeemed Israel: and beside all this, to day is the third day since these things were done. Yea, and certain women also of our company made us astonished, which were early at the sepulcher; And when they found not his body, they came, saying, that they had also seen a vision of angels, which said that he was alive. And certain of them which were with us went to the sepulcher, and found it even so as the women had said: but him they saw not. (Luke 24:19 24)

HIS ESCAPE TO EGYPT Hosea 11:1

When Israel was a child, then I loved him, and called my son out of Egypt.

And was there until the death of Herod: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, Out of Egypt have I called my son. (Mat. 2:15)

THE LOVE OF CHRIST IS SEEN Hosea 11:4

I drew them with cords of a man, with bands of love: and I was to them as they that take off the yoke on their jaws, and I laid meat unto them.

Come unto me, all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. (Mat. 11: 28-29)

NO OTHER SAVIOR BESIDE Hosea 13:4

Yet I am the LORD thy God from the land of Egypt, and thou shalt know no god but me: for there is no savior beside me.

Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved. (Acts 4:12)

THE RESURRECTION OF CHRIST IS SEEN Hosea 13:14

I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death: O death, I will be thy plagues; O grave, I will be thy destruction: repentance shall be hid from mine eyes.

So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory. O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory? (1 Cor 15:5455)

And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day. (John 6:40)

In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace. (Eph 1:7)

The Book of Joel

THE PROMISE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT BY CHRIST Joel 2:28

And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions:

But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and said unto them, Ye men of Judaea, and all ye that dwell at Jerusalem, be this known unto you, and hearken to my words: For these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is but the third hour of the day. But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel; And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy: And I will show wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke: The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before that great and notable day of the Lord come: And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved. And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved. (Acts 2:21)

The Book of Amos

DARKNESS AT NOON Amos 8:9

And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the Lord GOD, that I will cause the sun to go down at noon, and I will darken the earth in the clear day:

Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land unto the ninth hour. (Mat 27:45)

And the sun was darkened, and the veil of the temple was rent in the midst. (Luke 23:45)

CHRIST THE OF LORD OF HOST Amos 9:6

It is he that buildeth his stories in the heaven, and hath founded his troop in the earth; he that calleth for the waters of the sea, and poureth them out upon the face of the earth: JEHO-VAH IS HIS NAME.(in the original Hebrew).

Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Sion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believeth on him shall not be confounded. (1 Pet 2:6)

CHRIST WILL RESTORE THE TABERNACLE OF DAVID Amos 9:11

In that day will I raise up the tabernacle of David that is fallen, and close up the breaches thereof; and I will raise up his ruins, and I will build it as in the days of old:

And to this agree the words of the prophets; as it is written, After this I will return, and will build again the tabernacle of David, which is fallen down; and I will build again the ruins thereof, and I will set it up: That the residue of men might seek after the Lord, and all the Gentiles, upon whom my name is called, saith the Lord, who doeth all these things. (Acts 15:15 17)

The Book of Obadiah

THE KINGDOM SHALL BE THE LORD Obad. 1:21

And saviors shall come up on mount Zion to judge the mount of Esau; and the kingdom shall be the LORD'S.

And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever. (Rev 11:15)

The Book of Jonah

THE THREE DAYS AND THREE NIGHTS TYPE OF CHRIST'S BURIAL. Jonah 1:17

Now the LORD had prepared a great fish to swallow up Jonah. And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.

But he answered and said unto them, An evil and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given to it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas: For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. The Book of Micah

SMITTEN ON CHEEK Micah 5:1

Now gather thyself in troops, O daughter of troops: he hath laid siege against us: they shall smite the judge of Israel with a rod upon the cheek.

And they spit upon him, and took the reed, and smote him on the head. (Mat 27:30)

HIS BIRTH IN BETHLEHEM Micah 5:2

But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.

Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem, Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him. JESUS, THE CENTER OF PROPHECIES

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. (John 1:1-2)

Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was glad.

Wherefore of these men which have companied with us all the time that the Lord Jesus went in and out among us, Beginning from the baptism of John, unto that same day that he was taken up from

us, must one be ordained to be a witness with us of his resurrection. And they appointed two, Joseph called Barsabas, who was surnamed Justus, and Matthias. (Acts 1:20-23)

HIS INTERCESSION FOR HIS ENEMIES Ps. 109:4

For my love they are my adversaries: but I give myself unto prayer.

Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots. (Luke 23:34)

THEY SUBSTITUTED HIS LOVE FOR HATE Ps. 109:4-5

For my love they are my adversaries: but I give myself unto prayer. And they have rewarded me evil for good, and hatred for my love.

He came unto his own, and his own received him not. (John 1:11)

HE WAS RIDICULED Ps. 109:25

I became also a reproach unto them: when they looked upon me they shaked their heads.

Again, he sent forth other servants, saying, Tell them which are bidden, Behold, I have prepared my dinner: my oxen and my fatlings are killed, and all things are ready: come unto the marriage. (Mat. 22:4)

THE PLOWERS PLOWED UPON HIS BACK Ps. 129:1-3

A Song of degrees. Many a time have they afflicted me from my youth, may Israel now say: Many a time have they afflicted me from my youth: yet they have not prevailed against me. The plowers plowed upon my back: they made long their furrows.

Then released he Barabbas unto them: and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered him to be crucified. (Mat 27:26)

GAVE HIS BACK TO THE SMITERS Isa. 50:5-6

The Lord GOD hath opened mine ear, and I was not rebellious, neither turned away back. I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my face from shame and spitting.

Then released he Barabbas unto them: and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered him to be crucified. (Mat 27:26)

THE SUFFERING OF CHRIST ON THE CROSS Isa. 52:13

Behold, my servant shall deal prudently, he shall be exalted and extolled, and be very high.

And they stripped him, and put on him a scarlel robe And when they had platted a crown of thorns, they put it upon his head, and a reed in his right hand: and they bowed the knee before him, and mocked him, saying, Hail, King of the Jews! And they spit upon him, and took the reed, and smote him on the head. And after that they had mocked him, they took the robe off from him, and put his own raiment on him, and led him away to crucify him. (Mat. 27:27-31)

THE NEWS ABOUT THE SUBSTITUTIONARY DEATH IS TOO GOOD TO BE TRUE Isa. 53:1

Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed?

But though he had done so many miracles before them, yet they believed not on him: That the saying of Esaias the prophet might be fulfilled, which he spake, Lord, who hath believed our report? and to whom hath the arm of the Lord been revealed? Therefore they could not believe, because that Esaias said again, He hath blinded their eyes, and hardened their heart; that they should not see with their eyes, nor understand with their heart, and be converted, and I should heal them. (John 12:37-40)

Despised and rejected of men Isa. 53:3

He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

He came unto his own, and his own received him not. (John 1:11)

HE WAS WOUNDED FOR OUR TRANSGRESSION Isa 53:4

Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures: (1 Cor 15:3-4)

LED AS A LAMB TO THE SLAUGHTER Isa. 53:7

He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

The place of the scripture which he read was this, He was led as a sheep to the slaughter; and like a lamb dumb before his shearer, so opened he not his mouth: In his humiliation his judgment was taken away: and who shall declare his generation? for his life is taken from the earth. And the eunuch answered Philip, and said, I pray thee, of whom speaketh the prophet this? of himself, or of some other man? Then Philip opened his mouth, and began at the same scripture, and preached unto him Jesus. (Acts 8:32-35)

HE OPENED NOT HIS MOUTH Isa. 53:7

Then said Pilate unto him, Hearest thou not how many things they witness against thee? And he answered him to never a word; insomuch that the governor marvelled greatly. (Mat 27:13-1414)

FALSELY ACCUSED Isa. 53:8

He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.

And Jesus stood before the governor: and the governor asked him, saying, Art thou the King of the Jews? And Jesus said unto him, Thou sayest. And when he was accused of the chief priests and elders, he answered nothing. (Mat. 27:11-12)

MADE HIS GRAVE WITH THE WICKED Isa. 53:9

And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth.

Then were there two thieves crucified with him, one on the right hand, and another on the left. (Mat. 27:38)

HE DID NO WRONG Isa. 53:9

And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth.

Pilate saith unto them, What shall I do then with Jesus which is called Christ? They all say unto him, Let him be crucified. And the governor said, Why, what evil hath he done? But they cried out the more, saying, Let him be crucified. When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but that rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed his hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of this just person: see ye to it. Then answered all the people, and said, His blood be on us, and on our children. (Mat 27:22-25)

HIS SOUL WAS MADE AN OFFERING FOR SIN Isa. 53:10

Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.

He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things? (Rom 8:32)

HE SHALL JUSTIFY MANY, FOR HE SHALL BEAR THEIR INIQUITIES Isa. 53:11

He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.

Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life. For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous. (Rom 5:18-19)

HE WAS NUMBERED WITH THE TRANSGRESSORS Isa. 53:12

Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

And with him they crucify two thieves; the one on his right hand, and the other on his left. And the scripture was fulfilled, which saith, And he was numbered with the transgressors. (Mark 15:27-28)

HE BORE THE SIN OF MANY Isa. 53:12

Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out

his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation. (Heb 9:28)

HE MADE INTERCESSION FOR THE WICKED Isa. 53:12

Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

And when they were come to the place, which is called Calvary, there they crucified him, and the malefactors, one on the right hand, and the other on the left. Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots. (Luke 23:33-34)

THE MESSIAH SHALL BE CUT OFF, BUT NOT FOR HIMSELF Dan. 9:26

And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

Now Caiaphas was he, which gave counsel to the Jews, that it was expedient that one man should die for the people. (John 18:14)

DARKNESS AT NOON Amos 8:9

And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the Lord GOD, that I will cause the sun to go down at noon, and I will darken

the earth in the clear day:

Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land unto the ninth hour. (Mat. 27:45)

SOLD WITH THIRTY PIECES OF SILVER Zech 11:13

And the LORD said unto me, Cast it unto the potter: a goodly price that I was prised at of them. And I took the thirty pieces of silver, and cast them to the potter in the house of the LORD.

And said unto them, What will ye give me, and I will deliver him unto you? And they covenanted with him for thirty pieces of silver. (Mat 26:15)

PURCHASE OF THE POTTERS FILED Zech 11:13

And the LORD said unto me, Cast it unto the potter: a goodly price that I was prised at of them. And I took the thirty pieces of silver, and cast them to the potter in the house of the LORD.

Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, Saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed the innocent blood. And they said, What is that to us? see thou to that.

And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, and went and hanged himself. And the chief priests took the silver pieces, and said, It is not lawful for to put them into the treasury, because it is the price of blood. And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in. Wherefore that field was called, The field of blood, unto this day. PIERCED IN HIS SIDE Zech 12:10

And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his first-born.

But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water. And he that saw it bare record, and his record is true: and he knoweth that he saith true, that ye might believe. For these things were done, that the scripture should be fulfilled.
